## Notes

## Terms and Conditions

The Broker-Carrier Agreement or Carrier Agreement (in each case, the "Agreement") between Coyote Logistics, LLC, a Licensed Property Broker - USDOT # 2236410, and Eye1 Global Services LLC is amended by the verbal agreement between Chanz Harris of Coyote Logistics, LLC hereafter referred to as BROKER, and Rollin Stevenson of Eye1 Global Services LLC hereafter referred to as CARRIER, dated 01/28/2025.

This confirmation is subject to the terms of the Agreement and this document constitutes an amendment thereto. If the CARRIER has not signed the Agreement, then the rate shown above is the agreed individually negotiated rate and no other rate shall apply including any carrier tariff rate or terms.

THIS LOAD SHALL NOT BE DOUBLE BROKERED. No additional charges not listed above may be added by the CARRIER. Any additional charges must appear on a revised confirmation sheet signed by the BROKER. CARRIER must include signed copy of the shipper's bill of lading and any other proof of delivery with invoice to BROKER. Rates, except as specifically designated above, are inclusive of any fuel surcharge. CARRIER certifies that it is in compliance with all requirements of the California Air Resources Board (CARB) that are applicable to the scope of CARRIER's operations, including, but not limited to: Statewide Truck and Bus Regulations, Transport Refrigeration Unit (TRU) Regulations, Tractor-Trailer Greenhouse (GHG) Gas Regulations, and Drayage Truck Regulations. CARRIER also warrants that it is in compliance with any comparable requirements of the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and other states, where applicable. CARRIER shall be responsible for any fines imposed on BROKER and/or shipper resulting from noncompliance.

CARRIER hereby confirms that it maintains applicable and valid insurance without exclusions that would prevent coverage for the items listed above. CARRIER has at least \$100,000.00 in cargo insurance and \$1,000,000.00 in automobile liability coverage. CARRIER further confirms that in transporting the shipment described hereinabove, it will comply with all U.S. DOT and FDA regulations applicable to its operations while transporting said shipment, including, but not limited to drivers' hours of service, and the Food Safety Modernization Act (FSMA), if applicable. CARRIER agrees to the attached requirements from the shipper, if any.

### ALL LOADS ARE SUBJECT TO ELECTRONIC TRACKING

By accepting this shipment, CARRIER agrees that it has obtained a written agreement from each driver transporting a shipment tendered by BROKER to CARRIER pursuant to the Agreement in which each driver provides all necessary consents to (i) receiving text messages and/or phone calls from or on behalf of BROKER and (ii) allowing BROKER or its vendor to track such driver's location while transporting such shipment. CARRIER shall comply with all applicable laws relating to the collection, use, storage, retention, disclosure, and disposal of any information CARRIER provides to BROKER, including information regarding the drivers transporting shipments. CARRIER shall indemnify, defend, and hold BROKER and its affiliates harmless from and against any and all claims, damages, liabilities, losses, actions and expenses (including attorneys' fees) arising out of or in connection with CARRIER's breach of this Section. This Section shall survive the expiration or termination of the Agreement between BROKER and CARRIER.

### PROCESSING OF PERSONAL INFORMATION

With regard to personal information (information that describes, is capable of being associated with, or could reasonably be linked, directly or indirectly, with a particular consumer, household, or device) and data and/or information submitted by or on behalf of BROKER in connection with the shipment, CARRIER will only use and process such data and/or information for the purpose of performing the services hereunder and in compliance with applicable law. With regard to personal information collected, received, or otherwise used or processed by CARRIER hereunder, CARRIER shall not:

- (i) Sell, rent, release, disclose, disseminate, make available, transfer, or otherwise communicate orally, in writing, or by electronic or other means, personal information to another business or a third party for monetary or other valuable consideration; or
- (ii) Retain, disclose, collect, sell, use, or otherwise process personal information for any purpose other than for the specific purpose of, and as necessary for, performing the services hereunder. For clarity, CARRIER may not retain, use, or disclose the personal information for any other commercial purposes or outside of the direct business relationship between CARRIER and BROKER.

CARRIER will notify BROKER promptly via email at [privacy@coyote.com](mailto:privacy@coyote.com) within 2 business days of any breach of the requirements under this heading (PROCESSING OF PERSONAL INFORMATION) of if it receives any inquiry, complaint, request or claim from an individual relating to personal information. CARRIER will notify BROKER by emailing [privacy@coyote.com](mailto:privacy@coyote.com) within 24 hours of any security incident of which CARRIER becomes aware which affects, or could reasonably be expected to affect, the confidentiality, integrity, or availability of BROKER's information systems or any personal information, data, and/or information submitted by or on behalf of Broker in connection with the shipment.

**BakeMark Transportation Requirement for BRC**

BakeMark operates under the BRC (British Retail Consortium) global food safety and quality certification program. BRC Section 4.16 requires the following:

**4.16 Dispatch and transport**

Procedures shall be in place to ensure that the management of dispatch and of the vehicles and containers used for transporting products from the site do not present a risk to the safety, security or quality of the products.

4.16.1	Procedures to maintain product safety and quality during loading and transportation shall be developed and implemented. These may include as appropriate: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>controlling temperature of loading dock areas and vehicles.</li><li>the use of covered bays for vehicle loading or unloading.</li><li>securing loads on pallets to prevent movement during transit.</li><li>inspection of loads prior to dispatch.</li></ul>
4.16.2	All vehicles or containers used for the transport of raw materials and the dispatch of products shall be fit for purpose. This shall ensure that they are: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>in a clean condition.</li><li>free from strong odors which may cause taint to products.</li><li>in a suitable condition to prevent damage to products during transit.</li><li>equipped to ensure any temperature requirements can be maintained throughout transportation.</li><li>Records of inspections shall be maintained.</li></ul>
4.16.3	Where temperature control is required, the transport shall be capable of maintaining product temperature within specification, under minimum and maximum load. Temperature data-logging devices which can be interrogated to confirm time/temperature conditions or a system to monitor and record at predetermined frequencies the correct operation of refrigeration equipment shall be used and records maintained.
4.16.4	Maintenance systems and documented cleaning procedures shall be available for all vehicles and equipment used for loading/unloading. There shall be records of the measures taken.
4.16.5	The company shall have procedures for the transport of products, which shall include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>any restrictions on the use of mixed loads.</li><li>requirements for the security of products during transit, particularly when vehicles are parked and unattended.</li><li>clear instructions in the case of vehicle breakdown, accident or failure of refrigeration systems which ensure the safety of the products is assessed and records maintained.</li></ul>
4.16.6	Where the company employs third-party contractors, all the requirements specified in this section shall be clearly defined in the contract or terms and conditions and verified, or the contracted company shall be certificated to the Global Standard for Storage and Distribution or similar GFSI-recognized scheme.

As part of the BakeMark food safety policy, BakeMark reserves the right to perform random pre- scheduled on-site audits of the Carrier to confirm compliance with this transportation policy.
